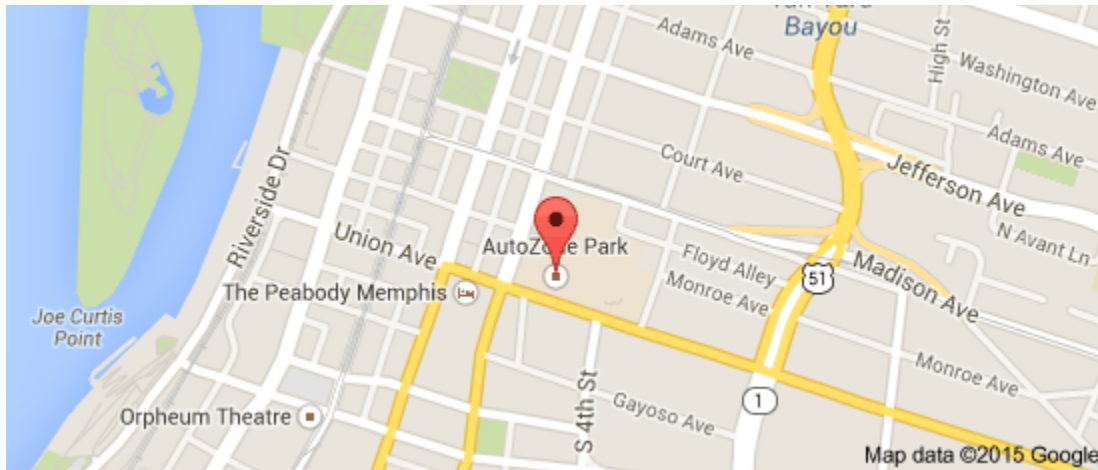


Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where will the event be held?

At AutoZone Park, the home of the Memphis Redbirds, in downtown Memphis at 200 Union Avenue.



2. Who is sponsoring the Memphis Exalts Jesus event?

A broad representation of the body of Christ in Memphis is working together to organize this gathering.

3. What about parking?

The stadium has advised all parking vendors around the park that there will be an event, and we expect them to be open. The price of parking varies from about \$10.00 for a garage to about \$5.00 for an open lot. There are some surrounding streets where free parallel parking is available on a first come first served basis.

4. My church wants to bring a bus. Where can we park?

5. How much does it cost to attend?

Admission is free, there is open seating and no advance ticket is required. A ticket will be handed to you at the gate.

6. What are the hours?

The gates open at 12:00 pm. Please arrive a bit early to get in. The event is from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday April 4, 2015. Please feel free to come for the whole time or any part that you can.

7. What should I expect?

The event will have praise & worship, prayer, exhortation from the Word of God, scripture reading, testimonies and much blessing of the Lord.

8. May we bring our children?

Yes! This is a family event. Families should plan to stay together in the park since there is no childcare or "children's activities" other than joining together in praise and worship of our dear Lord Jesus Christ.

9. Will there be interpreters for the Deaf and H/H?

10. Will there be food available at the park or can we bring food in?

There will be some concession food available for purchase, and the Redbirds have graciously allowed us to bring small food items, such as what might fit in your purse, and one plastic water bottle. No coolers and no glass.

11. Will there be emergency services on site?

Yes, there is a room set aside at the stadium for minor emergencies.

12. Will there be security on site?

Yes, normal stadium security will be in place.
